
The topics selected may be anything relevant to the department. HR issues, infrastructure (office/guest houses/ residence), simplification of procedures with respect to any topic, GST related issues, Customs, better relations with other organisations (police, IAS, CBI, state officers, CRPF , Airport Authorities etc) in a station, Swachh Bharat, vigilance issues, carrying uniform, cadre management, vehicles, training to officers at all levels, canteen upgradation, file management and any other best practices. The topics mentioned are only indicative and not exhaustive.

A committee of senior officers shall evaluate those papers and the selected/best ones shall be presented in the workshop by the concerned officer/s and shall be discussed at length for successful implementation of those ideas. The workshop shall be open for all to enable further value addition.

It is therefore once again requested that the officers may submit their papers latest by sep15, 2018.
